

## ULMAN CHRISTIAN CHURCH

The Ulman Christian Church property was a gift from Simeon Bear. Dedication was in 1921 with J. C. Thompson and W. H. Scott as Dedicatory speakers. The church board as of July 31, 1921 was: Clint Bilyeu, Rufus Crismon and C. B. Bass. The Charter reads:

We the undersigned having been immersed upon confession of our faith in Christ do unite to form the Christian church in Ulman, Missouri. We in having consecrated with God in Christ do hereby consecrate with each other that we will keep the ordinances and commandments of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ agreeing to be governed in our personal conduct and in our church relations and obligations by the law of Christ as taught in the New Testament and pledging each other to do all in our power to promote the peace and unity and prosperity of this church in all the world.

In testimony whereof we affix our respective names this the 14<sup>th</sup> day of August, 1919.
