

Square Dance Team Returns from Nashville

The Lake of the Ozarks Square Dance Team returned to their homes after a three weeks stay in Nashville, Tenn., where they were featured dancers and set background during the filming of several Grand Ole Opry shows.

The group made 40, thirty minute film shows which were in color and can be viewed by TV audiences in black and white or color.

These films may also be used as movie film shorts in theaters.

The dancers worked with the Grand Ole Opry stars, on their respective shows, and they were featured in the opening of each show and also set background until the finale, where their act was again featured.

Fiddlin' Billy Moore of the Ozark Opry Show was used during the shows as was Country Cousin Lee Mace and his bass fiddle act. Lee's act was featured in extra production shots during four of the shows.

Fiddlin' Billy was offered a position by "The Drifting Cowboys", a group of musicians who played for the late Hank Williams shows. Billy felt he was a part of the "Ozark Opry" cast and also feels it has a future of its own, so chose to remain in his present position.

While the group was in Nashville, they were guests of Mother Maybell and the Carter sisters at their home, Sunday of last week.

They reported a wonderful time in connection with their work, and members of the Ozark Opry cast gained valuable experience for their own stage show.
